

1. INTRODUCTION

Officers listed in this register may use the designation RHSO¹ (Register Highrisk Security Officer) after the surname as proof thereof.

2. OBJECTIVE

2.1

The purpose of the RHSO register is to enable security officers, who have demonstrated through continuing education, practical practice and training to possess high-quality knowledge, experience and skills, to be entered in a register, which can be consulted by the person(s) who have a need for services from that person.

3. ACCEPTED TRAINING AND WORK EXPERIENCE

3.1

The registered has the mandatory diploma in Security as well as at least 3 years of demonstrable continuous work experience.

3.2

Have fully completed the training programme and obtained a minimum of 295 PE points.

4. RIGHTS OF RHSO REGISTERED

4.1

For a period of 3 years during which he is registered in the register, the registrant is entitled to place the designation RHSO after his surname to indicate that he is registered as a Registered Highrisk Security Officer.

4.2

Upon request, the registrant is entitled to receive, free of charge, a list of those registered as RHSO. The list should be requested in writing to the secretariat of Centre of Experts, giving reasons.

5. DUTIES OF THE RSO REGISTERED

5.1

The registered person must earn a minimum of **295 PE² points** per registration period (= 3 years) by regularly participating in exercises as mentioned in the following article.

5.2

PE points can be gained from the following activities:

- a. attending presentations of lesson plans;
- b. practical practice of personal skills;
- c. practical practice of team skills;
- d. scenario training.

All exercises participated in were recorded by an RHSOI® registered exercise instructor in the RHSO registrant's security passport (in his or her name).
