

1. INTRODUCTION

Individuals listed in this register can add RHSOI1 (Register (Highrisk) Security Officer Instructor) after their surname as proof

2. OBJECTIVE

2.1

The RHSOI register aims at training instructors who have demonstrated through a quality audit their ability to guide security officers in Centre of Experts certification route of RSO® and/or RHSO® .

3. ACCEPTED TRAINING AND WORK EXPERIENCE

3.1

The RHSOI registered must have the Exercise Instructor Certificate, which will be issued by OrcaSecure BV or another Centre of Experts certified training institute upon completion of training.

3.2

The application for Centre of Experts certification will only be honoured if the person concerned has successfully completed a quality audit within 1 year of obtaining the Exercise Instructor Certificate (see document: Quality Standards Exercise Instructor) and article 5.1 et seq. of these register regulations.

4. RIGHTS OF RHSOI REGISTERED

4.1

For a period of 1 year during which he is registered in the register, the instructor is entitled to place the designation RHSOI after his surname to indicate that he is registered as a Registered (Highrisk) Security Officer Instructor.

4.2

Furthermore, the provisions of the Licence Agreement and Code of Conduct for Exercise Leaders shall apply.

4.3

Only RHSOI registered exercise instructors can nominate security officers to become RSO® or RHSO®, provided the requirements of the article are met: **Accepted training and work experience** of the relevant register regulations

4.4

Upon request, the registrant is entitled to receive, free of charge, a list of those registered as RHSOI. The list should be requested in writing to the secretariat of Centre of Experts, giving reasons.

Note:

Use of this list for commercial purposes (including: use as a mailing list for advertising communications) is not allowed.

5. DUTIES OF RHSOI REGISTERED

5.1

The registered is audited per registration period (= 1 year).

5.2

The quality audit takes place at the location where the RHSOI registered exercise instructor is working.

5.3

The RHSOI registered exercise instructor organises exercises for security guards and guides them towards RSO® or RHSO® certification in accordance with the provisions in the Licence Agreement and Code of Conduct for Exercise Leaders.

5.4

For the purpose of the annual audit, the registrant shall make the following documents available to the auditor prior to its commencement:

- a. The exercise policy plan
- b. The exercise annual plan for the current year
- c. Recorded learning moments from exercises
- d. A registry of managed security passports.

6. COE PRESENTATION OF RHSOI REGISTER DATA

6.1

Website: A site maintained by or on behalf of Centre of Experts on the World Wide Web (www.centreofexperts.nl) will feqtur the following data:

- surname;
- initials;
- prefix, academic title (limited to: bc, BA, BSc, MBA, MSc, MA, ir., ing., mr., drs., drs.) and,
- if requested by the registrant :his/her e-mail address and the URL of the website of his/her company or the employer's company.

6.2

Web link: In case the registered entrepreneur is, or has become, self-employed, entry of the URL shall take place only if an extract from the register shows of the Chamber of Commerce shows that his/her company was registeredat least three years before the date of the request for the URL listing.

7. FINAL PROVISIONS

7.1

Registrants are personally responsible for maintaining the timeliness, accuracy and completeness of the data included in the Centre of Experts register (see paragraph 6). To this end, they shall periodically consult the Centre of Experts website in this regard.
